THE PROCESS OF DRIVER'S EDUCATION FOR B-CERTIFICATION (GENERAL DRIVING LICENSE)

The study for a driving license can begin at the age of 16.



Apply for a study permit

The first thing a student needs to do is to apply for a study permit at a District Commissioner (Sýslumaður). You do this by completing an application form for a driving license.



Driving school 1

The student completes Driving School 1 (written material) along with the practical training.



Choosing a driving instructor

The student (or the parents of the student) selects a driving instructor and contacts him.



Practical driver's training

The student must complete at least 10 practice sessions in a car with a driving instructor before starting practice driving with a practice driving instructor. The driving instructor will determine when the student is ready for that.

Practice driving with a practice driving instructor. Apply for the practice permit at a District Commissioner. There can be more than one instructor.



Driving School 2

It's advisable to complete Driving School 2 three or four months before your 17th birthday.



Continuing training with a driving instructor.

Continuing practice in a car.



Driving School 3

Contains both written material and practice. Register on okuskoli3.is. Before starting Driving School 3, you must have completed Driving School 1 and Driving School 2 along with a minimum of 12 practice sessions in a car.



Written exam

The student orders a written exam at frumherji.is. The written exam may be taken up to two months before the 17th birthday.



Practical driver's training

Continuing practice in a car; at least a total of 15 practice sessions (in total from the beginning).



Practical exam

The practical exam (driving test in a car) can be taken up to two weeks before your 17th birthday. The driving instructor evaluates when you are ready for the practical exam and he will arrange it for you. The practical exam includes both driving proficiency and an oral exam.

The temporary driving license is valid for 3 years. If the student has no penalty points after 12 months, he or she can undergo driver's evaluation.



Driver's evaluation

The student contacts the driving instructor and undergoes a driver's evaluation.

Permanent license. The permanent license is valid for 15 years at a time.
